Please review each item in the Verification Checklist below and write your answers to each question. Consider what online or offline tools you could use, who you could talk to, and what clues in the photo can help you answer each question.



ORIGIN:

Find the original version of this image and identify where you found it.

- Identifying the origin of the image may prove difficult to students as they have not yet learned how to conduct a reverse image search. If students have difficulty, direct them by suggesting they try and find the oldest version of the image.
- The oldest version of the image can be found on Josephine Bohol Sabanal Abrinica's Facebook account.
 This photo was uploaded on October 23, 2020. Students may have found other posts on different social media accounts and news sources, but these images were a repost.
- A professional journalist might contact the couple or the photographer to confirm whether this image is the original version.

SOURCE:

Identify the name and username of the person who captured this image.

- Josephine Bohol Sabanal Abrinica is the person who captured this image and many of the reposts credit her with taking the photos.

DATE:

Identify when the image was captured. Please include the month, day, and year.

- The image was captured on October 23, 2020, the day of the couple's wedding.
- A journalist could further verify this by reaching out to the couple to confirm.

LOCATION:

Identify where this image was captured.

- The image appears to be captured in Barangay Luyang, Mabinay town. Students can verify this by looking at multiple news sources.

OBJECTIVE:

List what you believe the source's objectives were behind capturing and sharing this image.
